Bedrooms

Rose Court have a range of comfortable, relaxing and well-equipped bedrooms situated over three floors which are named Clarence, Windsor and Wilton. Each floor is home to a different type of care.

To personalise their bedroom Residents bring their own items of furniture and personal belongings such as ornaments and pictures.

Some bedrooms have en suite or washroom facilities; all are wheelchair friendly, have TV aerial points and a nurse call system.

Family and friends also have access to Rose Court's overnight stay room.

Dining experience

Our Chefs pride themselves in knowing the tastes of our Residents and preparing a choice of fresh, nutritional

meals and catering for any dietary and cultural needs.

We understand that meals are a very important part of our Residents' day, our menus cover a variety of choices for each meal and a choice of snacks, fresh fruit and refreshments are also available 24 hours a day.

Family and friends join Residents for meals which are served in the dining room or, if our Residents wish, they can choose to eat in the privacy of their own rooms.

Our Activities Co-ordinator spends time with Residents to ensure popular pastimes are included within the weekly activities calendar, this includes:

Our attractive courtyard and garden areas are very popular with Residents and the open and secure patio and decking areas are a tranquil place for Residents to relax or socialise with family and friends.

The garden room allows Residents to experience the outside inside and also features woodland sounds such as birds singing.
